Due to the nature of the project, and the City's need to expedite the environmental review of this project, your early response prior to the close of the 30-day period is greatly appreciated.

A public hearing will be held by the City Council at 7:00 pm on July 16, 2012, for the purpose of considering public comments regarding the Draft IS/ND. Both written comments and oral testimony from the public hearing will be incorporated into the final IS/ND to be adopted by the City Council. Please retain a copy of this document. Unless substantial modifications are needed, the Draft IS/ND plus an addendum may serve as the final document.

The proposed project consists of the construction of a new sanitary sewer relief line along 25th Avenue between Flores Street and South Delaware Street in San Mateo. The proposed project would range in size from 21 inches to 30 inches as a necessary improvement project to provide relief to the 18-inch sewer line in El Camino Real during wet weather events as well as capacity for accommodating planned upstream pipeline improvement projects to minimize the potential of sanitary sewer overflows.
