- **What is this handout?** This handout contains answers to frequently asked questions for bicycle parking.
- **How many bicycle parking spaces do I need?**

3 or more bedroom	0.15 spaces per unit	1.5 per unit	0.15 spaces per unit	1.5 per unit
<i>For other uses (i.e. offices, restaurants, and businesses) see SMMC 27.64.262.f. If the total number of required bicycle parking spaces contains a fraction of one-half or more, round up. If the fraction is less than one-half, round down.</i>				

- **What are the bicycle parking standards?**

Bicycle Parking Design and Placement Standards	
General Parking Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 4-ft. aisles for unobstructed access• 2.5 ft. (w) x 6 ft. (l)• Located in high-visibility areas (street frontage, building entrance); if not in high-visibility area, signage must be posted at the main building entrance• Must allow for the use of a U-type lock• Compatible/harmonious design and style with adjoining land uses• Shall not impede pedestrian or vehicular circulation
Short-term Parking Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two (2) points of contact to the bike frame• 30 in. of clearance• 3 ft. vertical clearance• Must be along project frontage and within 50 to 100 ft. (based on existing conditions) of main building entrance
Long-term Parking Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One (1) point of contact to the bike frame• Covered and located on-site within 200 ft. of main building entrance• Inclusion of a variety of parking arrangements (determined by Zoning Administrator)
