

# NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

January 14, 2020



Construction work on traffic calming measures along **31st Avenue between Fernwood and Edison** streets will begin soon.

## PROJECT OVERVIEW:

During the Hillsdale Traffic Action Plan process, residents identified 31st Avenue, between Fernwood and Edison streets, as a road prone to vehicle speeding. In response, staff conducted a speed survey and confirmed that vehicle speeds meet the City's threshold to install speed cushions.

Six speed cushions will be installed at the following locations on 31st Avenue:

- Between 602 and 566
- Between 536 and 530
- Between 404 and 3042
- Between 324 and 318
- Between 150 and 146
- Between 115 and 109
