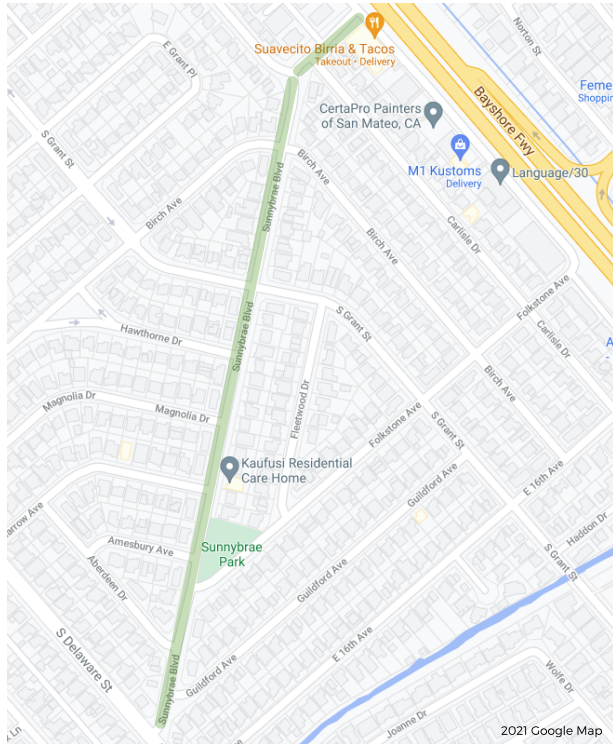


NOTICE OF PROJECT CHANGE

April 29, 2021



This notice is to inform you that the roadway paving for Sunnybrae Boulevard has been rescheduled to a later phase of the City's Smooth Streets program.

Another roadway segment recently experienced significant construction delays due to unanticipated soil conditions. The City will be conducting a more in-depth geotechnical evaluation along Sunnybrae Boulevard and considering a potential change in construction method to help avoid issues during construction in your neighborhood.

The improvements to Sunnybrae Boulevard from S. Delaware Street to S. Amphetlett Boulevard are rescheduled for construction in 2022.
