

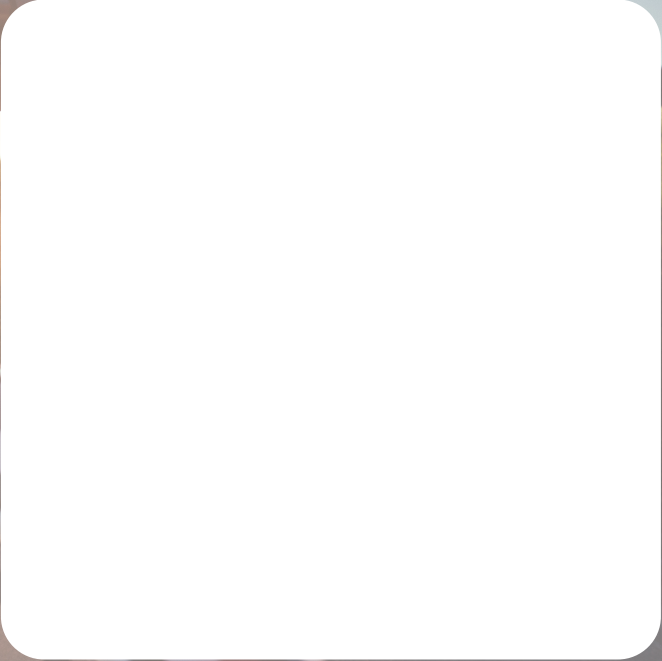

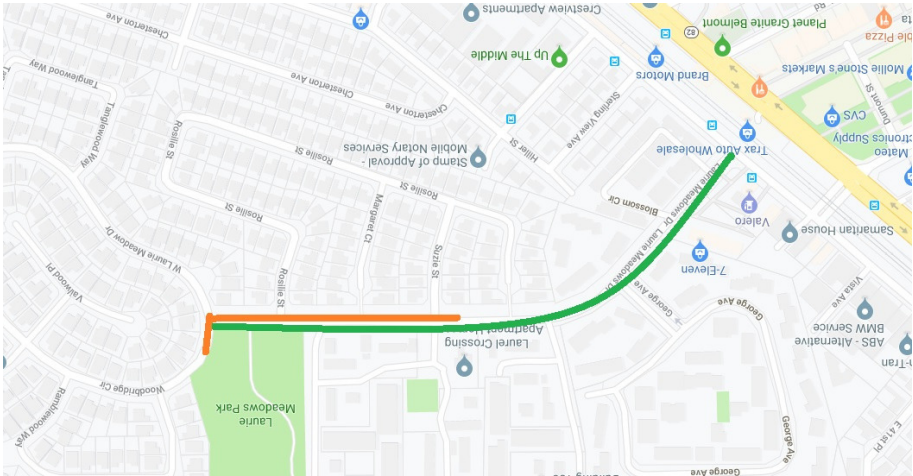

Safety Improvement Project



Clean Water Project



The City of San Mateo is preparing two concurrent infrastructure improvement projects in the Laurie Meadows community starting September 2019. Both projects will bring necessary upgrades to existing sewer facilities, roadway pavement, sidewalk accessibility, as well as, provide sustainable traffic flow and interconnectivity with citywide bike routes.



The work to upgrade your sewer infrastructure is one part of the Clean Water Program (CWP), the most significant upgrade to the City's sewer infrastructure in its modern history. This decade-long project will deliver improvements that will benefit the City's residents, future generations, and the San Francisco Bay Community.

LAURIE MEADOWS PEDESTRIAN & BICYCLE SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



The Public Works Department is creating a safer neighborhood for pedestrians and bicyclists and will be installing high visibility crosswalks, ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps, and traffic-calming bulb-outs. Additionally, the project will install Class II bike lanes in both directions and will resurface the entire length of Laurie Meadows Drive.

Project Location

Both projects are along Laurie Meadows Drive. The CWP work starts 300 feet west of Suzie Street to about 100 feet north of Woodbridge Circle and includes pump station upgrades in Laurie Meadows Park. The Safety Project will be from Pacific Boulevard to Woodbridge Circle.

Timeline

CWP work begins September 2019 through Summer 2020. The Safety Project begins Summer 2020 for about two months.

Work Zone

During both projects, expect at least one lane open in both directions. Please watch for traffic signs and construction crews.

What's Next

Contractors for both projects will notify the community in advance of construction work. The notifications will include construction dates, hours, and specific parking restrictions, if needed.
