


Infrastructure Improvements in Your Neighborhood

Safety Improvement Project

Clean Water Project

Completed



The City of San Mateo has now completed one of the two concurrent infrastructure improvement projects in your neighborhood. The next project starting soon will provide sustainable traffic flow and interconnectivity with citywide bike routes.

LAURIE MEADOWS PEDESTRIAN & BICYCLE SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Public Works Department is creating a safer neighborhood for pedestrians and bicyclists and will be installing high visibility crosswalks, ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps, and traffic-calming bulb-outs.

Additionally, the project will install Class II bike lanes in both directions and will resurface the entire length of Laurie Meadows Drive.



Project Location

The Safety Project will be from Pacific Boulevard to Woodbridge Circle.



Timeline

The Safety Project is expected to begin in spring 2021 for about three months.



Work Zone

Expect at least one lane open in both directions at the project location. Please watch for traffic signs and construction crews.



What's Next?

The City of San Mateo will issue notices once the project has been awarded to a contractor, then another notice when the construction schedule has been decided. The notifications will include construction dates, hours, and specific parking restrictions, if needed.
