

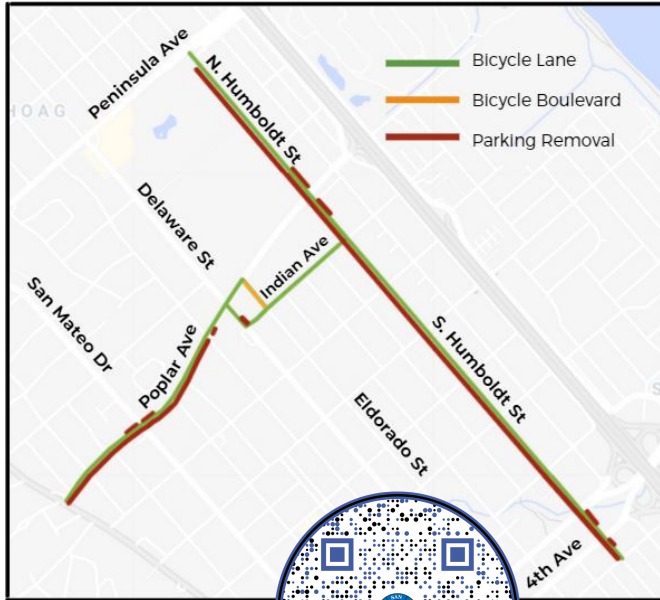

NOTICE OF PROJECT INTENT

NORTH CENTRAL BIKE LANES PROJECT



PROJECT MAP



The North Central Bike Lanes Project is planning to begin construction soon. City staff is recommending San Mateo City Council award the contract on Oct. 4, 2021. If awarded, construction would be scheduled soon after.

PROJECT DETAILS

The project will construct the 2nd and 4th highest priority projects in the 2020 Bicycle Master Plan. New bike lanes and a bicycle boulevard will be installed in your neighborhood.

PARKING REMOVAL CONSIDERATIONS

To accommodate all types of transportation, parking removal is planned on the south side of Poplar Avenue from El Camino Real to Delaware Street - 43 spaces (approximate), the east side of Delaware Street between Poplar Avenue and Indian Avenue - one space (approximate), and the west side of Humboldt Street from Peninsula Avenue to 5th Avenue - 170 spaces (approximate).

San Mateo property owners are legally and financially responsible for maintaining the sidewalk fronting their property in accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 17.24.

Looking to make improvements?

To protect its investment in street paving, the Department enacts a three-year street digging moratorium on all recently paved roads. Property owners considering improvements that may affect the street should complete their work prior to the City's upcoming project identified on the other side of this card.
